New SGA Member Policy

SGA Policy #28

In order to become an active member of the Student Government Association, a student must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be a matriculated student of SUNY Cobleskill with at least a 2.0 GPA.
- 2. Submit a letter of intent addressing the following: any leadership experience you have had that may be relevant as an SGA member, your reasons why you are interested in Student Government, what you hope to accomplish as a member and what you hope to learn through your experience.
- 3. Submit a weekly schedule to the Student Life Center Secretary.
- 4. Attend three meetings of the Student Government Association.
- 5. Participate in an assigned committee for at least two meetings.
- 6. Assist with SGA sponsored events and initiatives. This may include, but is not limited to, Blood Drive tabling, Club Council, polling stations, and recruiting initiatives. The Executive Board will determine the requirements for each event or initiative.
- 7. Attend a pre-member orientation meeting with an SGA advisor.
- 8. Attend a pre-member orientation meeting with a group of SGA members that may consist of a combination of Executive Board members and Elections Committee members.
- 9. Be elected into SGA through Elections Committee.

Active Member Definition

An active member of Student Government has accomplished all of the steps to becoming a member as outlined above and will then be a voting member and must follow the requirements of the Active Member Policy.
