

Request for Funds and SGA Recognition Policy

SGA Policy #15

- 1. All requests for additional funds from the Student Government will require that a spokesperson for the club making the request be present at the SGA meeting when the request is to be brought to the table.
- 2. All requests from interest groups to become a chartered club of the Student Government Association MUST have a spokesperson present at the SGA meeting when the club constitution is brought to the table.

Reasoning:

- 1. When voting on financial issues, the Student Government often needs more information about the use of the additional funds being requested. This would alleviate not only having to send the requests back to the Finance Committee, but also would provide more in-depth information about the request.
- 2. When creating a club, it is important that the Student Government fully understand the purpose and the resolve of the club being formed. The best way to see both the sincerity and the integrity of the proposed club is to have the members of the proposed club give a brief presentation explaining what they wish to accomplish, and how they will improve the extracurricular life of this campus.
