2019-2020 Receipt of SNAP Benefits

- The student.
- The student's parents (including a stepparent), if the student is a Dependent Student
- The student's spouse, if the student is married.
- The student's, spouse's or student's parent's other children if the parents will provide more than half of the children's support from July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020, or if the other children would be required to provide parental information if they were completing a FAFSA for 2019-2020. Include children who meet either of these standards even if the children do not live with the parents.
- Other people if they now live with the student and the student, spouse or parent provides more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support through June 30, 2019.

Note: If we have reason to believe that the information regarding the receipt of SNAP benefits is inaccurate, we may require documentation from the agency that issued the SNAP benefits in 2017 or 2018.
